Footnotes

POINTMAN TALKIN settled in hand, advanced between horses, checked hard inside the five-sixteenths pole, split rivals and came again entering the stretch, shifted out late and was up in the final strides. ENGINE ROOM pulled to contention between horses, was hemmed in and checked repeatedly into and through the turn, got through entering the stretch, opened clear and kept on well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. REWARDABLE stalked

the pace three wide, forged a brief lead leaving the turn but weakened between rivals and settled for a minor award. FIRST GOLD settled saving ground, shifted out split horses with a furlong to run and improved position. STAGE SUCCESS was close up four wide, offered a mild bid leaving the turn but failed to sustain the drive. COMMANDER JOHN rushed up between horses to dispute the pace, but weakened entering the stretch and gave way. LIVING broke slow, was unhurried into stride, swung six wide and finished with a belated gain. CANADIAN WISH was allowed to settle, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. CAT SPRINGS was rank to place along the inside, angled out to be clear but showed little. RIDGE CITY failed to respond. AWESOME ENCORE saved ground to little avail. SATANGO opened clear to set the pace, was collared after a half, stayed on to the stretch and faded fast.
