ARCHIE TRUCKER stalked the pace three wide, drew even entering the stretch, drifted in through the drive, was collared but dug in determinedly and came again to prevail narrowly. CHANCE AND A HALF settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch, drifted in through the drive but was gaining with every stride. READY'S ROCKET tracked the pace along the inside, bobbed inside the five-sixteenths pole, recovered quickly and angled out entering the stretch, seized the lead a furlong out but weakened between horses late and settled for the show. CAPE HATCHET was away alertly, contested the issue three wide, then along the inside entering the stretch, was caught in tight near the sixteenth pole and gave way. NORTHERN VOW settled in the second flight, came three wide, split horses and was making up ground late. SAVIANO chased the pace four wide but weakened leaving the turn and faded. PART OF MY FAMILY dueled for the lead along the inside to the stretch and gave way. YOU ALREADY KNOW broke a step slow, was rank to place and never a factor. ZEKE veered out at the start, was unhurried into stride and always outrun.
