STOP WATCH, reserved inside, advanced inside on the second turn, got through inside in upper stretch, gained command in midstretch and held sway late. COMIC STRIP rallied in company with the winner while outside that one, came out four wide into the stretch then finished willingly late. PRETORIAN, outrun for six furlongs, swerved out in upper stretch bumping TANSIT, then finished willingly late. SPAGHETTI HOUSE (GB) followed the winner on the second turn, reached a forward position in midstretch but weakened. PRORY, outrun to the stretch, improved his position while not a threat. TANSIT, forwardly placed off the inside, raced three wide on the second turn, was bumped in upper stretch and tired. PARK AVENUE vied for the lead inside, gained command before a half, came off the rail for the drive and tired. REFORMER RALLY, in tight after the start, was not a serious threat. HONEY'S ECLIPSE, forwardly placed three wide, gave way in the drive. RAY'S APPROVAL vied for the lead off the inside and faded.
