DR. KASHNIKOW, bumped at the start by JUST LIKE JIMMY when that one came out, was reserved soon after and positioned in behind rivals, raced three or four wide until the final quarter, angled seven wide when accelerating suddenly, collared the leaders in the final sixteenth and won going away under strong handling. TIJIYR (IRE), well placed between foes early, moved four wide on the backstretch, came out a bit farther entering the stretch and finished willingly as second best. STRATEGIC MISSION gained the lead early, moved near the inside, made the pace into the final furlong and grudgingly weakened. JUST LIKE JIMMY came out at the start bumping the winner, settled inside, eased out between horses three or four wide for the drive but lacked a serious late bid. SLOUGH CREEK settled three or four wide early, came out seven or eight wide for the stretch run but couldn't seriously threaten while improving position. MINOR WISDOM, close up inside early, eased outside of front-running STRATEGIC MISSION entering the backstretch to force the pace, gained near even terms at the furlong grounds but weakened soon after. MAKE NO MISTAKE (IRE), well placed from the outset, tracked the leaders four or five wide until the stretch and weakened gradually. NAT'S BIG PARTY, forwardly placed near the inside from early on, remained prominent until the final quarter and weakened.
