PONI COLADA outrun three wide, swung out five wide leaving the turn when rallying, made a bold run to the leader inside the final furlong and rapidly drew off. BOLD ABBOTT vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear into the stretch when asked but was no match for the winner late. BACETTO reserved early, moved out four wide midway through the turn and improved his position while no threat. OUR DANCER outrun along the inside, passed tiring rivals. VALID CITIZEN vied for the lead off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. CHESAPEAKE BAY reserved off the inside, could not menace. WHYWHY CAT prominent four wide, faded. SHONE could not menace while near the rail. BERLIOZ within striking distance three wide, faded. DA DA DA DUM never far back in the five path, faded after six furlongs. U D GHETTO prompted the pace three wide and stopped.
