DUMAR reserved for a half, made a solid middle move in the two path, split the leaders in midstretch and proved best under pressure. GRESHAM forwardly placed off the rail, moved to challenge four wide on the second turn and held on gamely. MYROSLAW outrun early, made a good five wide run on the second turn, challenged in midstretch but tired late. STAMP forwardly placed three wide, challenged on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch but tired in the final furlong. HOME FIELD outrun early four wide, raced in the two path on the second turn and could not threaten. ATTRACTIVE RIDE set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and faded. SUNDAYS BABY GRAND in the five path on the first turn, was no factor. TENMOR could not menace. DR. DUNKENSTEIN closest to the pace off the inside, stopped. After pulling up, DR DUNKENSTEIN was vanned off.
