Footnotes

HELEN BELEN close up from the start, challenged four wide on the turn, dropped back a bit in upper stretch then came again late. SPEEDACIOUS drifted out early, was straightened, set the pace off the inside, angled out for the drive and held on gamely despite attempting to drift out through the stretch. IRISH WITCH outrun early, raced four wide on the turn and improved her position while no threat. DANCES WITH ASHLEY forwardly placed, raced in the three path midway through the turn and tired in the drive. WON GREAT DAMSEL forced the pace three wide and gave way late. BELL'S SHOES close up along the inside, tired. THE UNDERLING lost her footing a bit at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, moved to a forward position five wide on the turn but faded in the drive.
