EVER SO LUCKY rushed to the lead between horses, shook off SATURDAY'S CHARM entering the stretch, opened clear and held safely. GOLDEN TICKET settled in hand, moved up four wide through the turn, angled in entering the stretch, finished well but failed to menace the winner. SATURDAY'S CHARM disputed the pace three wide, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. QUIET MAN settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and improved position. SLAMIT was allowed to settle, checked between horses near the half mile marker, came again four wide to make a mild gain. HARD BOURBON was allowed to settle, made a belated gain six wide. LET'S GO BEN was allowed to settle, came three wide to make a mild bid but flattened between horses. GOLDENEXPECTATIONS was hustled along five wide, but came up empty between rivals entering the stretch and faded. DO I DO broke slow, went greenly in traffic and was never a factor. ZEEZEE TAP was slow into stride and passed only the tiring ones. SMALL TOKEN pressed between horses for a half and dropped out. BLUEGRASS SHOES was close up along the inside to the turn and retreated.
