Footnotes

BINALEGEND, within striking distance off the inside, was angled out for the drive, caught the leaders in midstretch and was edging off late. ELAINES REASON, closest to the pace towards the inside, challenged before a half, gained a short lead in midstretch and held on well. TIME TO BLUFF, within striking distance, moved closer four wide on the turn, challenged in upper stretch but tired late. AMERICAN PASSAGE, within striking distance inside, lacked a closing bid. OBVIOUS FASHION bothered after breaking slowly, made a run inside on the turn but could not sustain the bid. FOB, forwardly placed between rivals, tired. JADEDUMDE, a bit sluggish at the start, advanced three wide on the turn but gave way in the drive. CALLMEANICEPICK drifted out four wide entering the turn and was not a threat. FIRE ME UP sprinted clear to set the pace but faded when displaced. TRU NUMBER, outrun early, raced four wide on the turn.
