Footnotes

OUT BY NOON sprinted clear to set the pace, came off the inside entering the stretch, moved back inside shortly thereafter and proved narrowly best while fully extended. FRANKIE CARL, unhurried early, advanced inside on the second turn, was angled out for the drive and finished willingly to miss. AMY MAE, within striking distance, moved closest to the winner three wide on the second turn, bumped with MAID BY THE FIRE in upper stretch, challenged the winner soon after and held on gamely. PRIVATE STASH, outrun for six furlongs, commenced her rally on the second turn and closed well. MAID BY THE FIRE, within striking distance inside, bumped with AMY MAE in upper stretch when lacking room then lacked clear room through the stretch. CASCO PASSAGE, forwardly placed three wide, continued well to the stretch and tired. LADY JAZZ was not a factor. CASH CRUNCH within striking distance three wide, faded. RUMBLE SEAT was not a factor. CRACKLIN MONA, closest to the pace off the inside, stopped after five furlongs.
