Footnotes

UNDERMINE, wearing a nasal strip, was bumped at the start and taken in hand soon after, moved inside raced three wide, lacked room at the quarter-mile ground while in behind rivals, moved to the rail when straightened for the drive and won going away under a mild hand ride. SUMMER SNOWFLAKE, within striking distance and saving ground from early on, edged up nearing the stretch, swung out six wide when straightened for the drive and couldn't threaten the winner as second best. DOROTHY ANN went up early to vie for the lead outside of MINER'S GAL, headed that one on the backstretch, surrendered the lead back to that one, took over again midway of the second turn but weakened in the drive. SOMETHINGBEAUTIFUL, well placed from the start, moved between rivals on the turn, loomed boldly in the upper stretch but flattened out. GHOST COLONY leaned in at the start bumping the winner, was outrun into the backstretch, reached contention as the field tightened nearing the stretch, came out seven wide for the drive but failed to respond. ONE BID, within easy striking distance while following the leaders four wide, flattened out in the drive. MINER'S GAL gained slim lead inside early, was displaced on the lead by DOROTHY ANN on the backstretch, regained the advantage but was through approaching the stretch.
