MAIL CALL, outrun to the far turn while four or five wide, angled seven abreast entering the stretch and was under brisk left-handed urging to draw clear late. BAY EAGLE settled three wide early, raced within easy striking distance and couldn't match strides with the winner in deep stretch. WAVE pressed front-running NITSCHKE four wide, gained a slim lead, showed the way into the final furlong and weakened. CATNIRO, checked and eased back nearing the first turn, eased out four or five wide, made a run into the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. LORD JONES moved inside early, saved ground throughout and failed to rally. NITSCHKE, hustled to the lead, made the pace to the far turn and faded.
