**Footnotes**

POWER SERGE leaned in at the start bumping SAVANNAH'S PRIZE, settled inside, rallied through close quarters at the three-sixteenths pole, took over leaving the eighth pole and drove clear. B B'S PLEASURE gained the lead early, maneuvered in three wide, made the pace into the final furlong and wasn't able to match strides with the winner thereafter. SAVANNAH'S PRIZE, bumped at the start by the winner, was outrun five wide to the stretch, came out eight abreast and offered a mild gain. REFLECTION BAY, nicely placed between rivals four or five wide into the stretch, came up empty. BROAD CREEK, well placed always, raced inside for a half, came out between foes four or five wide for the drive and flattened out. FLAIL worked her way inside, raced forwardly to the stretch and weakened. DASHING GIRL stalked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. GATOR MAID faded inside upon going a half. BLAZING COUNTESS drifted out at the start, raced in contention five or six wide to the lane and tired. CLASSY WORD never was close. PROPER PARADISE was outrun and raced eight or nine wide in the stretch.
