Footnotes

CAHILL HOLLY, close up inside from early on, took over about the sixteenth pole and drove clear under strong handling. WESTERN DOLL, well placed in behind the leaders early, moved four wide into the lane, reached the front at the furlong grounds but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. READY AND TOUGH, outrun for a half, ranged up five or six wide for the last eighth but could gain only slightly at the end. SET TO SPARKLE vied for the lead from early on while three or four wide, battled on even terms into the final furlong and weakened. CEDAR SUMMER, outrun near the inside into the lane, made a mild bid to reach contention at the furlong grounds and was empty late. BLUE MOON RISING raced forwardly four or five wide to the stretch and tired. DAZZLING RUBIES raced in contention off the inside for a half and faded.
