Footnotes

RED CHERRIES SPIN gained the lead early, raced in the three path, made the balance of the pace and was going away at the end under solid hand urging. NANCY'S ROSE chased the winner four wide from early on and wasn't a threat in the drive as second best. DAYLIGHT DANCER raced near the inside throughout and wasn't a threat to the top two while best of the rest. WATCH ME followed the leaders in a striking position five wide into the stretch and flattened out. DANDELION SUMMER, outrun to the stretch, made a minor bid to reach contention in the upper stretch and lacked a further account. ALMOST GOLD, well placed early while between foes four wide, weakened nearing the stretch. ARETE, outrun to the stretch, passed tired horses. SUMMER BROOK came out exchanging bumps with QUEEN SAM, raced forwardly three or four wide for a half and weakened in the drive. QUEEN SAM broke in and exchanged bumps with SUMMER BROOK after the start, then tired early. INDIAN CHIC raced near the inside and never menaced.
