Footnotes

HONCHIS'N PONCHIS settled along the inside under a tight hold, worked her way forward from between horses through the turn, angled out entering the stretch, reeled in the leader and quickly edged clear. PINA COLADA sped clear to dictate terms, continued on willingly through the drive but was no match for the winner. FILM CHARM was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance four wide, loomed a threat entering the stretch but weakened in the drive. SWEETEST SONG was unhurried along the inside, swung five wide to make a late rally and improved her position. YES IT'S BARBARA chased the pace three wide, angled in leaving the turn but faltered in the final furlong and faded. HOW FAR IS HEAVEN pressed the pace three wide, but came up empty from between horses on the turn and retreated. ARGYLE PINK broke in the air, rushed to contention four wide, but was used up after a half and dropped out. CAT AT PLAY angled in to save ground but lacked a response when called upon. A BIT OF HUMOR was always outrun.
