SANTANA STRINGS settled in hand, progressed four wide through the turn, took over entering the stretch and steadily drew clear. CHESAPEAKE BAY was allowed to settle, circled five wide and finished willingly to earn the place. CURLY settled saving ground, swung six wide leaving the turn and was along for the show. FORT APACHE STAR was slow into stride, circled six wide but found his best stride too late. SILVER BAYER was unhurried, came four wide

and improved position between rivals. NEED MONEY DAD was allowed to settle, closed the gap between horses on the turn, angled in entering the stretch and flattened during the drive. TACO DON was close up along the inside, worked his way to the outside entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. GO GETEM stalked the pace two wide, bid between horses leaving the turn, but came up empty entering the stretch. MR. SASS contended between horses three wide, drifted out further leaving the turn and tired. STEP TO THE MUSIC chased the pace three wide to the stretch and dropped out. GENTLEMAN SCHOLAR sped clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the turn and gave way readily once headed. TROIS DESIR broke in a tangle, rushed to contention between horses, but stopped before going a half.
