**Footnotes**

MARKETING MIX closest to the pace off the inside, challenged when ready on the second turn, drew off into the stretch when roused and stayed clear under steady urging. BIZZY CAROLINE reserved off the rail, waited around the second turn, angled to the rail once in the stretch and was gaining late. HUNGRY ISLAND unhurried for a half, advanced inside on the second turn, angled out when the runner up moved to the rail, split rivals in midstretch and rallied willingly late. SMART STING within striking distance off the inside, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. DON'T TELL SOPHIA stumbled at the start, was unhurried for a half, raced three wide on the second turn and made a solid late gain. TOURMALINE forwardly placed three wide, challenged from that path with three furlongs to go but weakened in the drive. GROUPIE DOLL outrun for a half, angled out a bit for the drive and made a late gain. HOLIDAYSATTHEFARM outrun to the stretch, found her best stride too late. NEW NORMAL set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. SEA LEVEL DRIVE within striking distance, save ground on the second turn and lacked a late bid. TRAC N JAM within striking distance, raced four wide midway through the second turn and tired.
