Footnotes

IRISTUKA, a bit sluggish early, was sent up inside to force the pace, rallied from the rail, took over, then was kept to her task. WILLA, within striking distance, saved ground until the stretch, came out seven wide for the drive and finished with good energy. MYTHICAL MYSTERY gained the lead early while racing off the inside, made the pace into the stretch and weakened. GO GO BLUE, outrun early, reached contention concluding the turn, remained prominent into the final furlong and came up empty. HOWELL'S HERO drifted out at the start and bumped DANCING NANCIES, moved up to stalk the leaders via wide, held on well into the final furlong and flattened out. DANCING NANCIES, bumped at the start, faded leaving the turn. RESCUER, sluggish to start, was hustled to contention and also tired after a half. SENSATIVE CINDY was outrun as was LA MANCHE. NATIVE GHOST gave way early.
