PROUD LITTLE PHONY swerved out at the start bumping SPUR CREEK, settled inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out and split foes three wide at the furlong grounds and edged clear under strong handling. CHIRIMOYA drifted in at the start bumping with DANCING LAUREL, raced five wide on the backstretch, moved up to press the pace entering the turn, took over in the upper stretch but couldn't handle the winner late. TRACI'S WILD, well placed four wide until the stretch, came up empty. DANCING LAUREL, bumped at the start by SPUR CREEK and forced out on DANCING LAUREL, raced in contention five wide until the stretch and lacked a serious late response. FRONT PAGE LADY gained the lead early, edged to race three wide, made the pace into the stretch and tired. SPUR CREEK, bumped at the start and forced out on DANCING LAUREL, tired nearing the stretch. FIRM KISS, outrun from the start, wasn't persevered with and was distanced.
