Footnotes

MISS LODI vied for the lead early while four wide, dueled inside of PONCHE DE LEONA before taking over, went along under careful handling, was engaged by SALTY FARMA a quarter-mile out, then won going away under urging. SALTY FARMA, never far back, made a bold bid nearing the final quarter, gained about even terms for the lead but failed to sustain the needed momentum as second best. JARAMAR RAIN, well placed near the inside to the stretch, continued inside for the drive but couldn't menace the top two. PONCHE DE LEONA gained the lead early, raced five or six wide, continued forwardly to the stretch and weakened. BENGALISA (ARG) never menaced. ING ING (FR), in contention for six furlongs while four wide, was empty in the drive. COTTAGE ROSE was never prominent.
