TRACI'S THUNDER was close up between horses, shifted out entering the stretch, wore down the leaders and edged clear late. MY ISABELL made a long drive five wide, forged a narrow lead entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. CHROME CRUISER stalked the pace, made her bid three wide, weakened during the drive but safely held the show. SLEW WATER SLEW settled saving ground, moved up through the turn, shifted out and split rivals entering the stretch and improved position through the stretch. MISS DEWEESE INLET broke in the air, was slow into stride, circled six wide and finished with a mild rally. ZIPPY CARLIE JOE was allowed to settle, swung six wide and made a belated gain. THUNDERING JILL opened clear to set the

pace, was collared on the turn and gave way readily once headed. BABY IT'S MINE was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and faded. I. D. THE MOON saved ground to little avail. CLASSIC EMILY showed little in a dull effort. ASHLYN'S GIRL was pinched back at the start, closed the gap three wide on the turn, was blocked entering the stretch, altered course but came up empty thereafter. LIONS N LEGS contended off of the inside, went wrong near the three-eighths pole, was pulled up on the turn and vanned off.
