**Footnotes**

SCOTUS settled in hand, advanced between horses on the second turn, bumped repeatedly with OAK MOTTE near the five-sixteenths pole, shook off that one entering the stretch, spilt horses and quickly drew away once clear. WEALTH TO ME lagged well back, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, came four wide into the lane, angled in and got through between rivals to earn the place. ISTHMUS disputed the pace two wide, opened clear and angled in after a half, was collared nearing the furlong marker, weakened but had enough left to hold the show. SLICK PARDONED ME was shuffled back early, tucked in to save ground, swung to the outside entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. TUTTI BUONA GENTE stalked the pace, came three wide to make his bid, but faltered between horses and faded. OAK MOTTE was allowed to settle four wide, was hemmed in between horses on the second turn, bumped repeatedly with the winner, lacked room entering the stretch, altered course to the outside but came up empty in the drive. COOL C NOTE contended between horses, shifted out four wide on the backstretch, tired after six furlongs and retreated. FAISAL PRINCE vied for the lead along the inside, tired leaving the second turn, hit the rail entering the stretch and showed little thereafter. CAUSIN' HAVOC saved ground to no avail.
