Footnotes

CHARMED GIFT, in hand early while tracking the dueling leaders three or four wide, moved four wide in steady fashion approaching the stretch, took over leaving the furlong grounds and edged clear under intermittent urging. JEANIE SUE, reserved early while three or four wide, made a run five wide into the upper stretch, couldn't threaten the winner late but gamely dead heated for second with EMERALDFORAJUDGE. The latter forced the pace early while three abreast, gained the advantage on the backstretch, drew clear on the second turn, then couldn't last while finishing evenly with JEANIE SUE. NERISSA, unhurried inside for six furlongs, came out between horses four wide for the drive and lacked a late response. WHAT A SWEEP, unhurried early and four wide for six furlongs, came out six or seven wide for the stretch run and failed to menace. BRILLIANT ASSET, a bit rank on the first turn while dueling for the lead from the inside, lost the edge on the backstretch to EMERALDFORAJUDGE, held on well for almost six furlongs and tired. DIXIE WITCH contested the pace from early on while between rivals, held on well for six furlongs and faded.
