Footnotes

BAYANI, rated in behind the leaders early, saved ground for six furlongs, eased out four wide to advance into the stretch, took over and was kept to her task. BORDER BLUES drifted out at the start and was checked, worked her way inside, saved ground, rallied from the rail and gamely earned second while unable to challenge the winner. SHAPES AND SHADOWS , within striking distance and five wide most of the way, loomed prominently into the final furlong but failed to produce the needed response. JOY OF IT ALL, in contention between foes there or four wide to the far turn, lost position soon after when dropping back inside, then offered a mild late gain when angled off the inside to race between foes four or five wide. FASHION SENSE eased in a bit after the start to race four or five wide, came out a bit farther on the course while advancing into the stretch but lacked a late bid. ALL SAINT'S EVE, never far back and saving ground to the stretch, moved out between rivals four or five wide but was empty the last eighth. SHOT GUN USS HOGA gained the lead early, maneuvered near the inside, made the pace until the final quarter and faltered. LA JOCONDE was outrun and seven or eight wide in the stretch run. UNSCRIPTED stalked front-running SHOT GUN USS HOGA four wide to the stretch and tired. FLING tracked the leaders in a striking position three or four wide for nearly six furlongs and tired.
