Footnotes

HERO'S TRIBUTE, bumped at the break by GREAT BLOOM and never far back, raced near the inside, rallied from the rail, then was fully extended to dead heat with GREAT BLOOM for first. GREAT BLOOM leaned in at the start bumping HERO'S TRIBUTE, followed the leaders from early on while five wide, advanced from that position into the stretch, put a head in front in deep stretch, then finished evenly with HERO'S TRIBUTE. INVESTOR'S DREAM (BRZ), within easy striking distance in behind horses to the stretch, moved out six wide and was gaining late. CHAMPALI gained the lead early, maneuvered near the inside, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened. CLASSIC PAR, outrun early, raced near the inside, circled horses eight wide into the stretch and offered a minor gain. TWILIGHT ROAD stalked the pace four wide, loomed menacingly between foes in the final furlong and came up empty. ASTROLOGIST, well placed near the inside between foes three or four wide to the lane, flattened out in the drive. RELAUNCH STAR went up early to press front-running CHAMPALI four wide, remained prominent between foes to the stretch and tired.
