Footnotes

BRUNILDA (ARG), outsprinted early, raced near the inside, eased out and split foes four wide in the final furlong and was fully extended to be up in time. FASHION GIRL, never far back, made a run five wide into the stretch, loomed boldly in the drive and was outfinished. CECELIA ROSE, in contention always, raced three wide into the stretch, was prominent inside the top two through the drive and wasn't quite good enough. LILA KAY'S ROSE gained the lead early, moved inside, drew well clear into the lane and couldn't last. OUR JOSEPHINA, outrun to the stretch, swung out six or seven wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. HELLO MATILDA, outrun early and off the inside, failed to rally. PARISIAN DEPUTY failed to menace. GOOD AS SILVER tracked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and tired. SHE'S A REBEL TOO, bumped at the start by STONEWAY, went up to contest the pace inside, held on well until the final quarter and tired. STONEWAY drifted in at the start bumping SHE'S A REBEL TOO, faded on the turn and was distanced.
