Footnotes

LIBERTY BULL, well placed inside from the start, angled out leaving the turn, bumped with LEMON SPICE forcing her out in the upper stretch to secure racing room, took over leaving the eighth pole and was hard ridden to hold sway. MORE THAN COOLIN, within striking distance and five or six wide was going well at the end but too late. CLANDESTINE FURY drifted in during the opening furlong, bumped with CONNECTICUT YANKEE, forced that one to take up when forced into the rail, continued inside, bumped with the winner at the five-sixteenths poles when lacking room, worked his way out four wide in deep stretch but wasn't good enough. JUICY POINT, away in good order, quickly settled three or four wide, made a run from between horses four wide into the final furlong and wasn't good enough. CROWNED GENERAL sprinted clear two wide, showed the way into the final furlong and weakened. LEMON SPICE stalked the pace four wide, was bumped and forced out for a couple of strides in the upper stretch by the winner when that one angled out, then flattened out soon after. MY PAL CHARLIE weakened leaving the turn. CONNECTICUT YANKEE, bumped by CLANDESTINE FURY and steadied when forced into the rail during the opening furlong, failed to reach contention. CONSTABULARY raced near the inside and tired entering the lane. UNO MACHO WHIZ broke slowly and was outrun.
