WIN GRAMMY BOY settled in hand, angled in on the turn to launch his bid, got through entering the stretch, reeled in the leaders and quickly drew clear. HE AIN'T RIGHT rushed up to vie for the lead along the inside, drifted out a bit entering the stretch, proved no match for the winner but kept on well to hold the place. PRINCE TETON settled saving ground, split horses to make a late rally and was making up ground late. CHECKSANDBALANCES settled in the second flight, closed the gap through the turn, altered course to the outside for the drive and continued on fairly well. KING ANDREW was forwardly placed three wide, was carried out leaving the turn and lacked a response when called upon. NEWPORT was slow into stride, angled in to save ground, got through to make a late gain but was left with too much to do. PACIFIC STAR attended the pace along the inside, but drifted out through the turn and came up empty in the drive. AZTEC KING was away alertly, dueled for the lead two wide to the final furlong and faded. N. Y. WISE GUY hopped at the start, dropped well back and passed only his tiring rivals. PRIZE MASTER was hustled along between horses while never far back for a half and tired. MAN O' WONDER raced wide throughout and was through early.
