CHOICE PLAY was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground, slipped through along the hedge to make her bid, closed with a rush and was up in the final strides. SEA GULL settled in hand toward the inside, worked her way to the outside from between horses, came five wide and finished full of run but was just kept at bay. BILL'S PRESENCE pressed the pace three wide, forged command nearing the three-eighths marker, opened clear through the second turn, kept on well through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the top two late. JOXY ROXY attended the pace along the inside, shifted out entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. RCUANDRY settled saving ground, angled out to make her bid but went evenly through the drive. LEINSTER LADY was forwardly placed three wide, loomed a threat entering the stretch but weakened slightly in the drive. SLICK MISS settled between horses, angled out to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. THROUGH THE CLOUDS was allowed to settle, came four wide to make a belated gain but was never a factor. A LITTLE OFF pulled to the fore to set the pace, was headed with three furlongs to run and gave way readily thereafter. TURN TO BERNSTEIN was hung wide throughout and showed little. DONERAILE BELLE was outrun. PASSION DU COEUR chased the pace four wide through the second turn and dropped out.
