MONSIGNOR tracked the pace two wide, drew even with five-sixteenths to run, shook clear entering the stretch and held a diminishing advantage. MOE MAN settled in hand within contention, split rivals to make his bid, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. MEDAL ROUND was allowed to settled three wide, angled out further to make his bid, loomed large with a furlong to run but lacked the needed late punch. PLUTONIUM opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the second turn and gave way through the final furlong. DOWN WITH DIXIE broke in the air to get away behind his field, was allowed to settle off of the inside, made a middle move four wide, drew even entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. MAX SILVERHAMMER settled saving ground, angled out to be clear entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. STIMULUS PLAN showed little. MACHO TORO was forwardly placed along the inside to the second turn and dropped out.
