Footnotes

TEND stalked the pace three wide, drew even between horses leaving the turn, poked his head in front with a furlong to run and was inching away late. EARLY RETURN was reserved off of the early pace, ranged up four wide to engage the leaders, drew to level terms entering the stretch, was stuck across the face by the whip of the jockey on TEND nearing the furlong marker and was kept at bay through a prolonged drive. RIVER BEAR broke a step slow, pulled to contention between horses, was blocked entering the stretch, steadied from tight quarters inside the furlong marker, jammed between rivals late and was making up ground. LIMESTONE EDGE was shuffled back between horses early, settled in hand, swung to the outside entering the stretch and was making up ground late. AGASTACHE contested the pace along the inside, weakened slightly following a prolonged drive and grudgingly gave way. GUAM TYPHOON pulled to the fore to set the disputed pace between rivals, weakened during the drive and faded in the final yards. KENSEI attended the pace along the inside, was hemmed in entering the stretch, lacked room to inside the sixteenth pole, altered course to the outside but went evenly through the final yards. SUCCESS SUCCESS failed to respond. Following a jockey objection and the Stewards inquiry into the stretch run, TEND was disqualified from first and placed second for having his jockey strike EARLY RETURN with the whip near the eighth pole.
