**Footnotes**

BAY HEAD stalked the pace off of the inside, launched a bold bid entering the stretch, swamped the leader nearing the furlong marker and drew off to prove much the best. ASTRONOMER was unhurried into stride, came five wide, finished well and was along for the show. EGYPTIAN WARRIOR pulled to the lead along the inside, disputed the issue to the final furlong, weakened but had enough left to hold the show. TAKEPOINTSANDRUN was allowed to settle, came four wide and finished with a mild rally between rivals. NORTHERN LUCK broke slow, was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. ALEXANDER THEGREAT passed only the tiring ones. DEHERE ON TOUR settled saving ground, but lacked a response when called upon. GREAT CALL contested the pace three wide to the stretch and faltered. CONTRAPUNTAL was through after a half.
