GOLIGHTLY, near the inside early, moved between horses four or five wide approaching the final quarter, then responded to stout left-handed whipping to wear down EMILY RING. The latter gained the lead early, raced near the inside on the turn, came well off the inside for the drive, managed a clear advantage into the final furlong and couldn't handle GOLIGHTLY late. SILK SAILS, outrun for a half, saved ground, worked her way out between horses four or five wide for the last eighth and offered a mild gain. DESIGNER PHONE, outrun for a half, made a bold run six wide into the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SOUTHERN TOUR stalked the leaders four or five wide into the stretch and came up empty. LEGENDARY LADY failed to rally. MY ALIBI moved up early to press front-running EMILY RING from the outside, angled inside that one for the final quarter but flattened out. DRESSED IN GOLD tired upon going a half. ROSE FRANCES raced forwardly between rivals until approaching the stretch and tired.
