### Footnotes

CHITIZ moved to the front two wide early, raced under light rating, turned back a bid from BUNKER leaving the second turn, reopened a clear advantage, then lasted under pressure. CELESTIAL COMET gained a forward position early, raced in behind the leaders to the lane, split foes three or four wide and was going well at the end. NISTLE'S CRUNCH, reserved early and between horses three wide, came out nine wide for the drive and came with too little, too late. FREE FIGHTER, steadied near the inside approaching the first turn, was never far back, raced three wide into the lane and couldn't offer the needed late gain. BIG GLEN stumbled at the start, settled behind foes, was outrun to the lane and managed a mild gain from the rail. WOODLAND FLOOD raced near the inside to the lane, eased out five wide for the drive and failed to fire. BUNKER eased out early to press the winner three or four wide, offered an earnest challenge at the quarter-mile ground but flattened out when straightened for the drive. CITIZEN JOHN stalked the pace four wide to the stretch and faltered. HORSE DOCTOR, within striking distance four or five wide to the upper stretch, came a bit wider for the final furlong and weakened. SOCKS raced four or five wide and weakened on the far turn.
