KITTEN'S JOY, in hand early while following the leaders four or five wide, edged closer entering the far turn, was put to a drive at the five-sixteenths pole, engaged front-running BOGANGLES a sixteenth out and proved gamely best under strong handling. BOGANGLES chased front-running WAR IMAGE four wide early, took over entering the upper stretch, opened a clear lead, then failed to contain the winner's surge. GRAND HERITAGE, in tight at the start, settled within easy striking distance three or four wide, rallied five wide into the lane and was gaining late. COMMANDMENT, outrun early, moved out six wide on the backstretch, came eight abreast into the stretch and improved position while not a serious threat. THORNHILL failed to rally. ORPHAN BRIGADE stalked the pace four wide to the far turn and weakened. WAR IMAGE gained the lead early, was rank entering the first turn, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened. GHAZI'S IMPALA, well placed inside for a half, tired soon after.
