### Footnotes

READY AND TOUGH gained the lead early, raced two or three wide, shook off a bid from EVERHEART on the turn, settled into the lane with a clear advantage and was going under hand urging the final sixteenth. EVERHEART chased the winner from the outset while four wide, offered a challenge on the turn but couldn't keep pace as second best. CEDAR SUMMER, six or seven wide, made a mild run into the upper stretch but failed to continue. BOJANGLE'S CAT, well placed four wide into the stretch, came up empty. FRONT LINE failed to rally. BRIGETTE'S DREAM, six or seven wide most of the way, wasn't a factor. POETS AND ANGELS faded on the turn while between rivals. SECRET PATRIOT raced in contention near the inside for five furlongs and tired.
