Footnotes

SHE'S A REBEL TOO, bumped after the start, went up to vie for the lead from between horses, gained a slight edge, made the balance of the pace and was hard ridden to hold sway. LILA KAY'S ROSE gained a slight advantage near the inside early, battled with the winner, was headed by SHE'S A REBEL TOO nearing the stretch, then held on stubbornly the remainder. O'LEE'S STORY, well placed four wide on the turn, came a bit wider into the lane, loomed prominently but couldn't get up. SUPERFLY GIRL, within striking distance and four wide into the stretch, lacked a serious late response. WEATHERWISE came out bumping the winner at the start, was well placed between foes and lacked a closing bid. CLEVER MAID, sluggish to start and in tight quarters, was outrun to the lane and not a serious threat while slightly improving position. DANSE KONGO raced three or four wide most of the way and was empty in the drive. ROSE OF PEMBROKE angled in early, force the pace three abreast to the stretch and tired. TRIESTE'S DESTINY raced near the inside and never menaced.
