### Footnotes

OVER THE EDGE, well placed inside from early on, moved three or four wide on the turn, took over in the upper stretch and kicked well clear under urging. ORANGE CRUSH sprinted clear at once, edged in two wide, made the pace to the stretch and wasn't a match for the winner in the drive while superior to the rest. ANGELS' SHARE, up close between foes early, continued four or five wide on the turn and couldn't challenge the top two in the stretch run. CLASSIFY, four or five wide, lacked a closing response. GEM SLEUTH, a forward factor between foes three or four wide, continued in a striking position to the stretch and flattened out. BROADBRUSH BEAUTY bobbed lightly at the start, was outrun for a half, circled foes eight wide into the lane and improved position. GALWAY LASS, bumped at the start by PRESIDENTIAL DATE, raced within striking distance four or five wide to the lane and weakened. SECRET START moved in three wide and failed to rally in an even effort. TRAINEE wasn't a factor. PRESIDENTIAL DATE came out at the start bumping GALWAY LASS and never was prominent. SPUNKY REDHEAD, sluggish to start and steadied, was through upon going a half. BRIGHT OUTLOOK was outrun.
