**Footnotes**

SILVER ON SILVER saved ground under patient handling for six furlongs, came out five wide to rally on the second turn, took over in the upper stretch and finished under solid hand urging. GOOD NIGHT, never far back, saved ground into the stretch, swung outside the winner when straightened for the drive, loomed a strong threat but couldn't offer a final response. THE KNIGHT SKY, wearing a nasal strip, was angled in behind the leaders early, saved ground, lacked room and was steadied nearing the final furlong, angled between foes when clear but failed to respond. BE VALIANT gained the lead early, maneuvered inside, made the pace until the stretch and tired. ROUGH GUIDE, outrun until the stretch, wasn't a threat while passing tired ones. GENERAL AVIATION, outrun till stretch, made a mild bid in the upper stretch but lacked a further account. TUZINAMA RUN tired at the far turn. AVIGATOR went up early to press front-running BE VALIANT from the outside, held on well until the stretch and tired. RIVER RAPTOR wasn't a factor. FERROSO (CHI) stalked the leaders four or five wide until the end of the backstretch and tired.
