Footnotes

CHERYL'S MYTH, unhurried into the backstretch, reached easy striking distance five wide, continued five wide into the lane, was bumped at the eighth pole by DEVIL AT THE WIRE, then continued on with good courage to capture a narrow decision. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE, unhurried early, followed the leaders six wide from the backstretch on, loomed boldly through the drive while continuing off the inside and missed. DEVIL AT THE WIRE went up early to force the pace four wide, gained a slim lead approaching the stretch, lost the edge to GREENBACK GAL from the inside nearing the final furlong, came out bumping with CHERYL'S MYTH for a stride soon after, then wasn't good enough. NAULT, well placed early, raced near the inside, lost position on the backstretch, continued inside, came out entering the upper stretch, split foes four wide and slowly was gaining. GREENBACK GAL settled the inside, advanced four or five wide into the stretch, gained a slim lead briefly at the furlong grounds but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. YACHT CLUB settled inside early, was outrun for six furlongs, came out four or five wide for the drive but failed to rally. BRIDGET SAYS gained the lead near the inside early, made the pace while dueling, held on well into the final furlong and had little left. SAND SPRINGS was used early while between foes, gave way and was eased late. TRICKY DEAL broke slowly, moved up six wide to stalk the pace, drifted out on the backstretch, bore out badly approaching the stretch and was eased in the late going when hopelessly beaten.
