Footnotes

CARSON'S STAR angled in early to force the pace four wide, battled on even terms through the final quarter and proved gamely best under strong handling. BORNINtheyouessay gained the lead near the inside early, raced two or three wide, was headed from the inside at the eighth pole and held on stubbornly the remainder to maintain the place. BELLO EDEN, never far back, raced near the rail, made a bold run to reach the front a furlong out but wasn't quite good enough at the end. RECUSE, always well placed and three or four wide, was empty in the late going. CAT RUNNER, within easy striking distance, made a solid run five wide into the final furlong but failed to continue. BERNIE'S ON STAGE, outsprinted early, never threatened while improving position slightly. SOMETIMES SWEET, outrun for a half and near the inside throughout, lacked a closing bid. CHARISMAGIC failed to reach contention. CLASSY CRIMSON raced near the inside and failed to reach contention. PRINCESS LARNEY was done after a half. GOLDIANA was outrun. CHART faded upon going a half.
