Footnotes

SO GIFTED gained the lead early, moved in three or four wide, made the balance of the pace and was kept to his task. RAPID RAJ, well placed four or five wide into the stretch, was just off the winner for the final furlong but couldn't offer the needed response as second best. BOOTS ARE WALKING, within striking distance four or five wide into deep stretch, could gain only slightly. JOSE, never far back and inside early, eased out four wide for the drive, loomed a solid threat but failed to fire. RAHY'S SECRET, outrun for three furlongs, came out eight wide entering the stretch an offered a minor gain. PRIZE STORY, bumped at the start and steadied, raced four or five wide and lacked a serious response. SWISSLE STICK chased the winner to the stretch while four or five wide and weakened gradually. BOLA SOUP swerved out at the start and failed to menace. GAMBLE MONGER bobbed at the start drifted out at the start bumping PRIZE STORY, raced forwardly for three furlongs near the inside and weakened. LORD OF MORAY never was prominent.
