Footnotes

EASILY, bumped at the start and forced in slightly on SOUL SEARCH, was never far back, raced four wide, inched to the front just before going six furlongs, then was kept to her task in the drive. LADY PEGASUS, extremely difficult to load into the gate which delayed the start, was never far back, raced three wide for six furlongs, maneuvered out five wide for the drive, loomed a solid threat but wasn't good enough. ONE STORMY MAMA gained the lead early, raced thee wide, made the pace for nearly six furlongs, lost the edge to the winner, then weakened grudgingly in the drive. ESPLANADE leaned in at the start bumping the winner, tracked the pace four wide, battled on even terms to the stretch and couldn't keep pace. SOUL SEARCH, bumped at the break by the winner when EASILY was forced in, settled early, reached easy striking distance on the far turn, came out five or six wide for the drive but was empty late. DADDY'S PETUNIA raced near the inside and weakened in the stretch run. RIMROC GOLD, in contention for six furlongs while three or four wide, weakened gradually in the drive.
