Footnotes

JUNIOR COLLEGE moved to the front two wide, went along under careful handling, increased his lead into the upper stretch and widened under intermittent urging in a sharp score. SANTANA STRINGS hopped at the start, settled three wide, fanned five wide into the lane and was up for the place while no threat to the winner. CELLULOID HERO chased the winner three or four wide into the final furlong and came up empty. THREE HOUR NAP, bumped by COUGAR CAT when breaking sluggishly, was outrun to the lane and managed a mild gain. ISLAND WARRIOR stalked the pace four wide to the stretch and flattened out. COUGAR CAT came out at the break bumping with THREE HOUR NAP, raced in a striking position two or three wide to the stretch and weakened. COACH JIMI LEE, up close between foes after the start, was eased back leaving the backstretch, then weakened gradually.
