GREAT EXUMA closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. SPEEDING TRAIN forwardly placed off the rail, moved out a path on the second turn, reached a challenging position midway through that turn, could not stay with the winner into the stretch but continued on gamely to be second best. BEST APPROVAL reserved off the rail, angled out to be five wide late on the second turn and improved his position while no threat. STING JAMES outrun early, made a five wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. BUCKY within striking distance inside, moved out three wide with three furlongs to go and tired. SPLURGING sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace for a half along the inside, held on well to the stretch and faded. BULLINACHINASHOP was no factor. D. C. GENE within reach of the leaders three wide, moved out

a path on the second turn and gave way. COURSE MADE GOOD was no factor. DARKWATCH four wide throughout, never menaced. FORT MOULTRIE forwardly placed in the three path, faded. BEN TENACIOUS was no threat.
