Footnotes

VEE ONE ROTATE settled in hand between horses, took closer order through the second turn, shifted out five wide entering the stretch and wore down the leaders in the final strides. CHARLIES SWELL opened clear to set the pace, repelled the challenge of AU MOON leaving the second turn, edged away entering the stretch, was collared again inside the sixteenth pole, drifted out through the drive and was denied in the shadow of the wire. WAR ROMANCE was allowed to settle, ranged up five wide, was collared between horses entering the stretch, was put in tight late when CHARLIES SWELL came out, checked and lost his best chance. ENERGIZED was allowed to settle, advanced between horses through the second turn, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. CAMPTON was jostled at the start and rank to place, finished with a belated gain and improved position. AU MOON stalked the pace, moved up to engage the leader midway through the second turn, but weakened in the final furlong. SAVAGE VOW bumped with CAMPTON at the start, was close up between rivals, angled in leaving the second turn, but came up empty entering the stretch and retreated. JON RON was bumped at the start, was unhurried into stride and was never a factor. PARTY HARD was forwardly placed along the inside to the second turn and dropped out. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the run nearing the wire and for drifting out and taking the path of WAR ROMANCE late, CHARLIES SWELL was disqualified from second and placed third.
