FUNK gained the lead early, controlled the pace under careful handling while two or three wide, put away CONSERVATIONIST leaving the eighth pole and drove clear. SCIPION stalked the pace five wide, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong but wasn't good enough while fully extended to earn the place. PATRIOT ACT, unhurried early, advanced four or five wide approaching the final quarter, continued off the inside and offered a mild gain. CONSERVATIONIST pressed the winner four or five wide into the final furlong and weakened. COMMANDER PAT, in hand early and four wide, raced within easy striking distance to the stretch and came up empty. INDY STORM settled near the inside and failed to rally. BARGAINWITHTHDEVIL weakened on the far turn and was seven wide in the stretch run. NEUF DE CARREAU followed the leaders four or five wide in a striking position for six furlongs and tired. SULTAN OF SPIN, away in good order, quickly settled, then never menaced. FUNK WAS INADVERTENTLY SCRATCHED BY THE MUTUEL DEPARTMENT. HE RAN FOR PURSE MONEY ONLY.
