Footnotes

WHAT A CHARACTER, never far back and five wide, came wider when leaving the turn, took over approaching the final furlong and was under urging to prevail. GEORGE RAY settled along the inside soon after the start, was always well placed, had aim from the rail in the late going and wasn't good enough. ASHEN LORD, outrun to the turn, fanned seven wide into the upper stretch and was slowly gaining at the end. MR. CHAMP, outrun for six furlong and between foes four wide, came wider into the lane and managed a mild gain. STARBASE went up to vie for the lead from between horses early, raced on even terms for the lead into the upper stretch and weakened. LUMBERJACK CAT saved ground most of the way and couldn't muster a closing bid. FANTASTIC BUD gained a forward position early while four or five wide, was asked for more about the five-sixteenths pole, moved menacingly into the upper stretch and flattened out. EVERYTHING'S ROSIE forced the pace three abreast to the head of the stretch and tired. TRICK N SKIP never was prominent. LEGENDS WAY weakened nearing the stretch. SIR HILLARY battled for the lead along the inside for nearly six furlongs and faltered.
