### Footnotes

FLYING CIRCLE, outsprinted early and four or five wide to the stretch, maneuvered six or seven wide for the drive, then closed determinedly to be along in time while lugging in a bit on or just past the wire. TALETOBETOLD, well placed from the outset and three or four wide, moved five wide into the lane, loomed boldly between foes at the very end and was in slightly close quarters on or just past the wire. SMITTY'S SUNSHINE, a bit sluggish to start, tracked the pace four wide, gained the edge in the upper stretch and couldn't last. CAT ON A CLOUD went up to duel for the lead early while three or four wide, gained even terms between foes in the upper stretch, continued with good courage, then was steadied on or just past the wire while weakening in tight quarters. INDIAN BREEZE, five or six wide much of the way, could gain only slightly at the end. MARINA BALLERINA gained a narrow lead two wide early while dueling with CAT ON A CLOUD, battled heads apart into the upper stretch and weakened. PUT AWAY THE HALO raced two or three wide much of the way and was empty in the drive. MISS WELLSRING, outrun three wide to the lane, came out five wide and never fired. HOT STORM was outrun and ten wide in the stretch run. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN INVOLVING THE STRETCH RUN. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
